## COHOUSING IN MILAN

Designed by **Dainelli Studio**, **Aria Hub** is a project with a new community spirit, with the aim of enhancing the value of Ortica, a rapidly expanding quarter of **Milan** 

**R**eopening the city to young people the new student residence opened in a phase of recovery and revival of the Milanese quarter of Ortica, long connected with the world of design and art. Aria Hub is the cohousing project by Dainelli Studio, which involved a

makeover of a whole early 20th-century building laid out on four levels with eight apartments of different sizes and floor plans, a common room with sofas and tables and a laundry room. The goal was to create personal and customizable accommodation,







settings with a marked aesthetic value that respect the constraints of a low-budget project. The surfaces, designed in a conservative perspective, present a mix of stone, parquet and original period tiles together with the new collection of Monoscopio ceramic surfaces by Dainelli Studio for Ceramica Bardelli The definition of the spaces, guided by the principle of minimalism and functionality, marks structurally similar areas with different colors, used for ceilings, fixed furnishings and kitchens. The furnishings and accessories include modern objects and customized features combined with design icons of Artemide, Flos, Hay, Kartell and Calligaris. Carolina Trabattoni
